AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KNOX COUNTY ORDINANCE 2013-1 GOVERNING THE USE OF HURDLAND AND BARING SEVER RECREATIONAL AREAS

WHEREAS, the Knox County Commission passed and approved Knox County Ordinance 2013-1 establishing rules for the use of Hurdland and Baring Sever Recreational Areas; and

WHEREAS, the Knox County Commission now wishes to amend certain sections of ordinance 2013-1, for the purpose of improving public use of Hurdland and Baring Sever Recreational Areas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, that Knox County Ordinance 2013-1 be amended as follows:

Section 4, Section 5, Section 6, and Section 8-a shall be repealed and replaced with the following:

Section 4:

No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle or other motor vehicle anywhere other than on designated graveled areas, within the Sever Recreational Areas except by special permit issued by the Knox County Commission.

Section 5:

The use of firearms within the Sever Recreational Areas shall be by permit only, issued by the Knox County Commission. Said permit shall specify the hours which firearm use is permitted, and the specific areas of the Sever Recreational Areas upon which firearms may be discharged.

Section 6:

The use of fireworks within the Sever Recreational Areas shall be by permit only, issued by the Knox County Commission. Said permit shall specify the hours in which fireworks may be discharged, and the specific areas within the Sever Recreational Areas upon which fireworks may be used.

Section 8-a

Hunting within the Sever Recreational Areas shall be by permit only, issued by the Knox County Commission. Said permit shall specify the hours during which hunting is to be allowed, and the specific areas of the Sever Recreational Areas upon which hunting is allowed. Hunting permits shall be issued in limited number at the discretion of the Knox County Commission in accordance with hunting practices.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KNOX COUNTY, MISSOURI. PASSED THIS 21 DAY OF 2017.
